PILIPINAS KONG MAHAL

RAGRAGSAKAN

The word "ragragsakan" is an Ilocano word which means merriment. This dance portrays the walk of the industrious Kalinga women balancing labba baskets placed on their heads as they carry the things the people need during merrymaking, which usually takes place during triumphant returns of headhunters or successful peace pacts between rival tribes. A colorful hand-woven "blankets of life" were also worn around their necks. Their walk imitates the climb up the Rice Terraces in the Mountain Provinces of the Philippines.

CUYO DANCE

Literally, Sayaw sa Cuyo means a dance in Cuyo. Accordingly, Cuyo is the oldest town in Palawan and became its second capital from 1873 to 1903. It has a culture of its own that has been preserved for over 350 years. Hence, this Mazurka-inspired Filipino folk dance with European influence originated in this town as people celebrate its culture during their town fiesta in honor of St. Augustine, the town's Patron Saint. This dance is mostly danced by girls swaying their hats to accent their turnings and twirls.

A Columbia Fil-Am Youth Scholarship program has been discussed often since the formation of the Association in 1991. Officially started in 2002 by the FAAGC Executive Board through the initiative of Peter Liunoras (FAAGC President, 2001-2003), the Columbia Fil-Am Scholarship awards are given to Fil-Am college-bound high school graduates whose families are currently paid FAAGC members and who (or their parents) have participated actively in Fil-Am activities. As specified by the Executive Board recently, current criteria are involvement in FAAGC (50percent), academics (30 percent), and interview and essay (20 percent).

Funds for the scholarship program are generated from, among others, donations, raffles during FAAGC gala, Christmas and Valentine's Day events, food sales at basketball tournaments, and from 2004 to 2010, fund-raisers by the Ridge View High School (RVHS) Fil-Am Youth Club under the direction of Peter Liunoras.

Starting in 2021, long-time member and supporter Dr. Francisco Sy has established and endowed the Dr. Francisco S. Sy Scholarship Fund of the FAAGC.

FAAGC presented the first Columbia Fil-Am Scholarship award at the 13th Annual Gala on September 13, 2003. Since then, award certificates (and checks) have been presented to deserving and qualified students every year during the annual gala or at special events. Interestingly, most of the past scholarship recipients had been Columbia Fil-Am Cultural Dance Troupe performers at one time or another.

BLAST FROM THE PAST ... 30 YEARS AGO ... (First FAAGC Gala ~~~ Sept. 7, 1991)

[Editor's note: The following article, reprinted here verbatim for its FAAGC historical perspective, appeared in the October 1, 1991 issue (Vol. 1, No. 7, page 5) of Mabuhay, the Columbia Fil-Am official newsletter then and the forerunner of the Fil-Am Bulletin. 1



Looking back at . . .

THE FIRST INAUGURAL BALL

Indeed: September 7, 1991 at The Marriott-Downtown Columbia was a memorable event. For the first time, the Filipino-American Association of Greater Columbia, S.C., was officially recognized, with its officers inducted in a gala affair.

The evening was ushered in with an aura of excited expectancy. Present early were the officers, ushers and usherettes, who made last minute checks to insure everything was in order.

Pat, our official photographer from Lancelot Studios, remarked that, had she known there would be many lovely and good-looking Filipinos, she could have brought her backgrounds to capture in portraits the loveliness around.

The guests arrived, exceeding the number we anticipated. In the maze of this predicament, the officers, notably the president, made quick negotiations with hotel personnel for additional table settings to accommodate everyone.

Fr. Max Saldua then gave the Invocation and dinner followed, with some musical entertainment in the background. Notable were Romel **Lacson** in his resonant tenor singing "Minamahal Kita," and Cindy Tefft in her melodious voice in "Anything for You." With her evocative style, Eva Rigney certainly reawakened "ghosts" of past and current loves with her rendition of "Unchained Melodv." Not to be outdone were volunteers from the audience: Zeny Lazaro, Edie Sebastian and Rudy Arbis.

The program officially began with **Romel Lacson** lead-

ing the singing of the Philippine and American national anthems, invoking the duality in some of us. The President, Eva Rigney, then gave her opening remarks, welcoming everybody and stressing the need for unity. This was followed by the induction of officers by our legal counsel, David E. Rigney. In carefully worded phrases, he reminded the officers of their duties and obligations to the Association. **Cindy Tefft** this time sang the Visayan song "Walay Angay." On the piano was Lorna de Guzman exhibiting her dexterity; impromptu or rehearsed, she can accompany iust as well.

In her fabulous costume, Lily Ragsdale performed the pangalay dance. The Asukal quartet held its own in harmony, singing original compositions stressing themes of social equality, friendship and cooperation. Remy Sarmiento briefly introduced our guest speaker, retired Lt. Gen. Charles W. Bagnal. Appropriately given a standing ovation, he showed depth of understanding about Asian culture, including our own. Mostly, for promoting Filipino American relationship, we salute him.

Now, the hit of the evening
— the *tinikling* dance. Our
hats off to the remarkable
dancers: Al Pasicatan, Cindy
Tefft, Roger Lacson, and
Michelle Pasicatan. Special
recognition is given to the
dance director — Eva Rigney,
and to the bamboo clickers —
Carrie, Winslow, Eva and
Susan, for taking good care of
those ankles. A choral group
from Charleston then enter-

tained us with their medley of traditional Filipino folk songs; we do thank them for joining us. Lastly, **Jun David** gave the closing remarks, thanking all those present.


Our emcee, Minnie Wheedleton, announced the opening of the dance - to the delight of many. Lerov Anderson and his partner were the DJs providing the music; the Association would like to thank them for their generosity. As dancing progressed to different beats, the amplifier malfunctioned. Undaunted, dancers continued on with a back-up boom-box and our own talented singers (George David, Romel Lacson, and Asukal) contributing their share. Lilv Ragsdale performed two more dances (a Spanish dance and the snake dance.)

On the whole, it was a successful affair and those who attended had a grand time! Our youth for the most part danced to the last music and reluctantly called the evening off.

FEEDBACK

A sequel to the inaugural ball was our general monthly meeting the day after the event. Part of the agenda was to gather feedback, positive or otherwise, about the affair. We can't over-emphasize the positives as already mentioned. On the other hand, among the other comments were the following: the program was quite long, the delay in starting the dinner and the program, the need for more dancing time.

In response the Association will try to trim the program as essentially allowable to give



time for more dancing. The emphasis, however, is to inject Filipino art, dances, other customs and tradition as we see fit

The delay in starting dinner and the program was an offshoot of the overwhelming last -minute response of our guests. As the day of the event loomed, the number of paid tickets was a little short of the hotel's minimal requirement for an affair like ours. To encourage more members and guests to come, ticket sales continued until the day of the ball. We apologize for the delay and appreciate the patience and understanding given. We also would like to thank the last-minute guests; we're glad they came. We will try to set deadline for ticket sales as situation and needs dictate.

On the side was a suggestion of asking a flat rate for everybody. It is the Association's stand, strongly encouraged by the president, to consider certain special situations where we will make room for some flexibility and adjustments. We like to assume the position to include everybody as practically feasible.

As the saying goes, for the Inaugural Ball, "All's well that ends well." We would like to see you all again in our upcoming functions.




