

FAAGC Scholarship Information Guide

The FAAGC Scholarship is for deserving high school seniors who are children of active members of FAAGC for at least the past two years. This scholarship is awarded in recognition of the applicant's academic achievements, contributions to FAAGC, and involvement in extracurricular and other community activities.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Submit completed application form and current photo by **April 30**. Application form is in this post.
2. Submit an official document from the school showing the applicant's GPA.
3. Submit two letters of recommendation from two adults not related to the applicant - such as a teacher, a member of FAAGC, or other community member who knows the applicant. These letters should address the applicant's character, strengths, dedication to and completion of assigned tasks, etc. *Be sure to ask them to send their letters by email to niemcnulty@gmail.com.
4. Submit an essay or statement written by the applicant explaining
 - a) her/his goals and aspirations
 - b) how FAAGC and others (like family, school, friends, etc.) have impacted or influenced these goals and aspirations
5. Once the application is complete, the applicant will be asked to have an interview with the Scholarship Committee, either face to face or virtually. The interview must be done before **May 30**.

GPA	25	4.0 and above will get the maximum points - 25 pts. 3.9 will get 24 points, 3.8, 23 points, and so on
Contribution/ involvement of applicant in FAAGC	20	Points will depend on the quality and quantity of the contributions
Involvement of parents in FAAGC	10	Points will depend on the quality and quantity of the contributions
Recommendation Letter 1	10	Points will depend on the strength of the recommendations and details or examples about specific items
Recommendation Letter 2	10	Points will depend on the strength of the recommendations and details or examples about specific items
Written Essay	15	Points will depend on how the applicant responds to questions
Interview	10	Points will depend on how the applicant responds to questions
